What's new in EXAKT version 4.2 coming up in June 07:

EXAKT Version 4.2 includes a variety of new options. The main advancements are in the decision criteria which now include cost, availability, and combined cost with availability. This latter option is an important new addition; previously, EXAKT version 4 permitted only the cost optimization model. Version 4.2 provides the opportunity for the user to optimize on a combination of costs and availability. This takes into account those occasions (for example) when replacement costs may be low, but availability becomes an issue because the replacement time is extended.
